Registrar's Updates (Sarah Kessler/Fiona Liken/Kristin Drapela/Nikki Hon)

- New DegreeWorks tutorial
 - New design is more modern + ADA compliant + intuitive
 - Displays information in collapsible visual cards for the audit rather than a dashboard view
 - Included handy links in the responsive dashboard (SAGE, Athena, Bulletin, etc.)
 - Application is scalable making it mobile + tablet friendly
 - New features: general elective count, residency requirement checkbox, Honors requirements completion card, major GPA in major card, etc.
 - Minors will still be viewable in the new application; certificates will eventually be added
 - Office of the Registrar will send out an email to advisors + students on Monday (4/24) that will include the following information:
 - DW will undergo maintenance April 26-28 but will still be accessible for use
 - The new interface will be in place starting May 1
 - There will be tutorials available on the website
 - Team will provide a training opportunity on April 27
 - Registrar will be at the Advising Workshop to go over the new interface with all advisors
 - Functionality will be exactly the same creating plans, providing exceptions, etc.
 - Degreeworks updates will be in the UGA 101 modules

• SAGE Updates (Prince Duepa + Jamaal Hinton)

- Updated admissions term
 - Currently, a student has to be registered for a course for the admission term to be shown
 - Working to get it updated so that course registration isn't required
 - Transfer services needs to be able to actively filter for incoming transfer students and needed to get them before they have registered for a course
- SAGE support team is also working to include some additional fields in the major change report, as well as, creating a process that will allow the reports be sent out at a designated time for individuals
- SAGE support team did want to identify there were a few faculty members that did not receive the most recent progress survey they have identified issues on their end + SAGE's end + will work to correct those before the fall
- Update: Dropped from Banner Error on Major Change Reports
 - There are currently a number of students that are showing as removed from banner on the major change report after changing their major
 - Don't automatically remove these students from your roster investigate closer

- Career Ladder + Staff Competencies/Performance Evals
 - Allison sent out an email earlier this week with a OneDrive link for Staff Competencies.
 Once there is a more complete document it will be added to the Advising website
 - Greg + Julia met with L+D director to see if we were on the right track with OID + campus initiatives and received support for the document
 - Julia has been working on an info session for the dossier, geared for advisors but supervisors are welcome, too
 - Aim for late summer dates, after July 1 to know advisor eligibility
 - Website will be up + running by this time

- SAGE Progress Survey Question
 - There has been a request to make Tier 2 + Tier 3 send an emergency notification email that would come through automatically
 - Not a lot of opinions/advisor feedback on the matter this meeting, so team will revisit at September meeting – potentially use Fall for trial to put it on both Tier 2 + Tier 3
 - This semester's results:
 - 382 Tier 2 concerns
 - 208 Tier 3 concerns
 - These surveys went to all faculty teaching an undergraduate course

- Financial Aid
 - Confusion around how to guide students about the new CPOS implications for pursuing two majors
 - Julia met with OSFA to discuss other ways for the office to communicate with students
 - Currently, the team is leaning towards getting feedback from this group of advisors about common dual degrees that students are doing to be able to provide targeted outreach (graphics, info sessions, etc.)
 - Note: OSFA likes to meet with students one-on-one whenever possible, so please don't feel like you are overloading them if you send students their way
